Public Health Department (GGD)

The Public Health Department protects, promotes and monitors the health and well-being of children and youth aged 0 to 23. Children aged 0 to 4 year and their parents receive care and guidance that is provided by the Baby Clinic. The growth and development of newborns is monitored and the vaccination program executed. Subsequently, the preventative care continues through school where children are called in for a preventative health examination at the age of 5,10 and 13 years. The healthcare professionals of the Public Health Department are prepared to provide the students who attend primary or secondary school with accurate health education. Health education builds students' knowledge, skills, and positive attitudes about health. It also motivates students to improve and maintain their health, prevent disease, and reduce risky behaviors.

In order to provide the best quality of youth health care the Public Health Department collaborates closely with other organizations on Sint Eustatius and in the Netherlands. Each partner organization has knowledge and expertise that is necessary to support the youth of Sint Eustatius in developing to healthy adults and a strong community.

The Island labor department DAZ (Dienst Arbeid Zaken) provides the following services for youth:

- Summer job program for ages 17 to 23
- Subsidized Day care program for young mothers that wants to go to school or work (no age limit)
- Food Bank program for young adults that are having difficulty providing for themselves or their family (no age limit)
- Job program together with New Challenges Foundation geared towards helping drop outs to get into the job market.

Together with the NCF, Labor department is assisting the youth from secondary level giving them insight into the demands of the local labor market, and helping drop outs join the labor market.

The social worker has a referral role when it comes to youth people who are in need of support.

The Buzzy Bees Inn Daycare Centre on the Island of St. Eustatius is an organization that caters to the care education and development aspects of children ages 0-12 years old.

The facility boasts a Daycare for preschoolers as well as After-care services. Daycare children are nurtured by being cuddled, sung to, and stimulated by finger play, action songs, toys and other developmental materials. Preschool children have staggered arrivals which begin at 7 am they participate in singing, nursery rhyme, outdoor play, arts and crafts, sand and water play, small and large group activities, fieldtrips and centered activities. The activities are designed to cater to their cognitive, social, emotional, psychological and physical needs.

After-care children come in from other Elementary schools on the Island. They receive tutoring, homework assistance as well as participate in sport, arts & crafts and other activities. Half day children receive a hot lunch, while full-day children receive their lunch as well as afternoon snack. The Daycare accommodates children ages 0 months to 4 years in the morning hours: however, some of the children remain for a full day program. The Aftercare program accommodates children ages 3-12 years old in the afternoon.

The Buzzy Bees Inn Daycare center caters to 125 children between the ages of 0-12 years. The children at the Buzzy Bees are divided into 5 age groups.

The Court of Guardianship performs research to be able to advise the court concerning the well-being of minors who are threatened within their environment. The Court of Guardianship investigator mainly analyzes the dynamics of family, parenting and the custody of minors in seriously threatening situations. The investigator speaks to all parties, collects and analyzes available information and advises the juvenile court or the prosecutor, based on the findings. The Court of Guardianship also mediate between parents when it concerns child support and in civil cases with parents and their minor children

In principle The Court of Guardianship performs all types of investigations in all four mission areas: protection, custody and visitation after separation, criminal and ASAA. ASAA stands for Renouncement, Screening (of prospective foster and adoptive families), Adoption and Lineage inquiries. The Investigators are trained in areas of the development of minors within the different stages of their development, basic civil law and are mediators only in cases that has to go to court.

The Court of Guardianship provide services to minors aged 0-17 years and parents in general.

Our highest priority is the safety and well- being of every child. The Court of Guardianship adheres to the guidelines as set forth in their quality framework which forms the basis for transparent and target oriented (investigative) procedures. This approach not only benefits our clients but also promotes clear communication between organizations with a common goal and facilitates a clear distinction of our respective tasks.
